

This is a non-exhaustive chart to help you keep track of what will be going on week to week with an average bathroom remodel. Every remodel is different, but most things listed here will occur or need to be addressed. The larger the bathroom, the more time might be needed as well. We can make written modifications to fit your remodel, and any other issues will be addressed during the bid process.

Cabinet hardware should be chosen as well. This may need to be even earlier depending on which cabinet provider we use. Countertop/any granite/quartzite material should be picked at this point
Week 4	☐ Tile ☐ Glass measured if used	 □ Paint color should be selected for walls and trim/ceiling if you have a preference (we have a standard white color used for both) □ If getting a custom mirror, the frame needs to be picked out by this time
Week 5	Cabinet install, measure for countertop install Trim installed Paint applied	☐ All mechanical trims should be picked out ☐ Faucets, towel racks/etc, toilet if you wish (we have a standard one supplied by plumber if needed), vanity lighting, any other lights ☐ Buy lightbulbs
Week 6	Countertop installed Mechanicals trimmed out Faucets, shower system, and toilet installed Lighting installed Towel racks et al installed Self-bought mirrors installed	
Week 7	☐ Glass is installed ☐ Custom mirrors installed ☐ Clean up and dumpster hauled away
